## **RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING HUNTING ON CCPD PROPERTY**

1. This hunt is open to **Clark County Residents and property owners ONLY**  
(Must register in advance see #2 and #3)
2. Hunters that did not turn in their Harvest Card from the prior year will not have hunting privileges for the current year. They can apply with the District to have their eligibility reinstated for the following year.
3. Resident Hunters must register in advance at the OFFICE and receive a harvest card and wallet card prior to hunting.
4. **EARN-A-BUCK-PROGRAM- All hunters must first harvest a doe** (Antlerless button bucks do not qualify as a verified harvest for the Buck allowance) and **MUST** have it verified by the District staff. No Photos will be allowed. Park District staff must confirm and note the harvest on the Harvest Card to allow for any Buck to be harvested.
5. Hunting must take place from a stationary location; **NO** stalking is allowed and or herding.
6. Hunting from portable blinds and removable stands are allowed (Climbers and ladder) Stands are allowed to be placed for the season with the following rules and regulations.
  - A. Non-refundable fee of \$50.00 per season per stand.
  - B. May place stand no earlier than the first day of season.
  - C. Stand/Blind must be removed the last day of season.
  - D. Stand/Blind must have visible permit with current year information that can be seen from the ground.
  - E. No visible permit will result in stand/blind being removed and forfeited.
  - F. Location of stand/blind shall be GPS coordinated and the location reported to the CCPD.
  - G. No permanent structures allowed all stand/blind shall be portable and removed on the last day of the season.
  - H. No two stand/blind shall be within 250' of another.
  - I. Stand/blind may be moved with immediate notification to CCPD.
  - J. Clark County Park District reserves the right to remove or confiscate any stand/blind for any reason.
  - K. Any violation of any rule or regulation shall be grounds for revocation of rights to hunt on Clark County Park District property.
7. **No trees may be removed or pruned to allow for shooting lanes. Any destruction of plant material is a violation of the Clark County Park District Ordinances and will be subject to fines and loss of hunting privileges for a term of one year.**
8. Hunters must have in their possession their harvest card while in the field and present this to District Staff upon request. Hunters must display their windshield card in their vehicle anytime they are in the field. Failure to carry and display this information may result in expulsion for the hunting season.
9. Hunters under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
10. Hunters will be allowed to harvest Turkeys during the Archery season consistent with IDNR rules, season regulations and permits held by the hunter.

11. Hunters will be allowed to Harvest Squirrels on the ground only. Anyone caught shooting into trees will be removed from the park and will be permanently barred from hunting on the District's property. Squirrel season dates, rules and regulations will be determined by IDNR and hunting will only be allowed during the Park Open Archery dates listed.
12. **Hunters must mail or deliver their completed deer harvest card to the Clark County Park District by February 14 to be eligible to sign up for the Hunt for the following season.**
13. **All Illinois Department of Natural Resources rules and regulations apply to this hunt, please see the Illinois Digest of Hunting Regulations for further information.**
14. **Open dates:** There are three locations that will be open for hunting. Please refer to our website for the opening dates for each location.

15. NO Archery Hunting is allowed on any other areas of the Clark County Park District property other than those identified on the website and posted at the District office.
